Kangaroo Island

Kangaroo Island is located 16km off the coast of South Australia.

A natural wilderness in its purest sense

- **Coordinates $35^{\circ}50'S137^{\circ}20'E/35.833^{\circ}S 137.333^{\circ}E$**
- **Area $4,405\text{km}^2$ Coastline 540km**
- **Length 150km Width .9km to 57km**
- **Main town is Kingscote**
- **Population 4612 as at June 2012**



Kangaroo Island

Access to Kangaroo Island is easily achieved via a 45minute ferry trip departing from Cape Jervis, south of Adelaide or a 25minute flight from Adelaide. Bookings for both ferry and flight are essential to guarantee availability.

Self Drive touring – We recommend self-driving as the most affordable and convenient way to experience Kangaroo Island and its many attractions. We recommend you stay 3 -4 days.

Kangaroo Island Wilderness retreat is only 1.5 – 2 hours drive from the Sealink ferry terminal or 1 hours drive from the Kingscote airport.

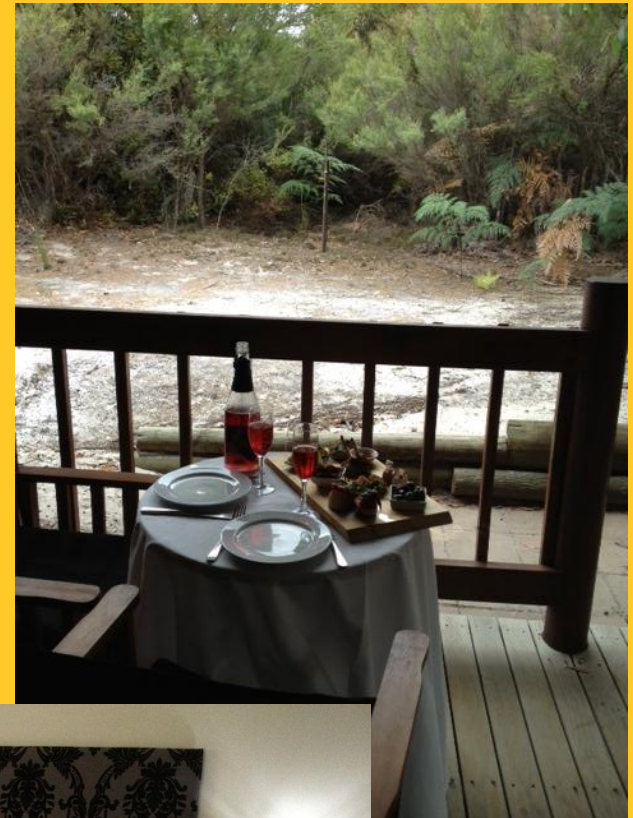

Flinders Chase National Park is 34,000 hectares of unspoilt wilderness, cultural heritage sites, numerous lighthouse history and unspoilt rivers and beaches. It has walks of varying levels of challenge and hikes for hours or even days.

Hanson Bay Wildlife Sanctuary – experience the wild at night with a nocturnal tour and see the animals in their natural habitat.

Seal Bay Conservation Park – the third largest population of Australia Sea-lion. Guided beach tours allow you observe the natural behaviour of the sea lions up close.















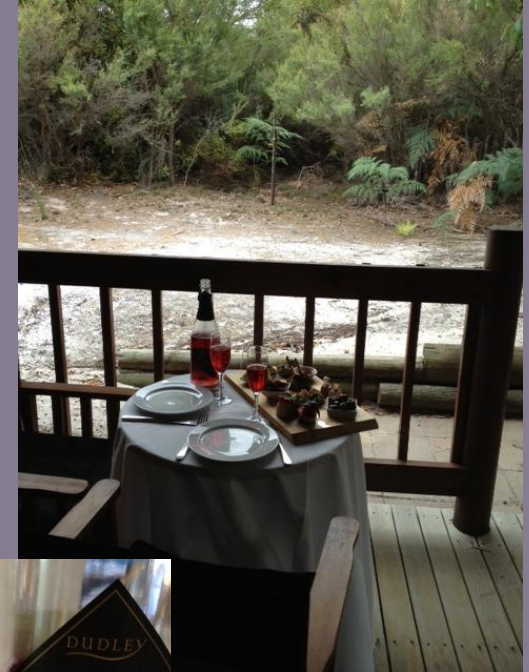
